1. Under what circumstances do the Siltbusters discharge water via the overflow pipes? Does this indicate that drainage ponds 1 and 2 are full?

Siltbuster discharges are active and ongoing for the management of construction site runoff, depending on prevailing weather conditions, as rainfall runoff arises on-site and the available freeboard within attenuation ponds decreases. This will continue during the construction phase until the permanent track and land drainage scheme is implemented.

2. For how many days (in the last month) has this discharge occurred?

Using the period mid-Dec 23 to mid-Jan 24 as a representation of wet-weather conditions, per records provided by our water management team, operational and consented discharge via the Siltbusters treating water from Pond 2 occurred on 20-days. This is wholly dependent on prevailing weather conditions.

3. Is the South Heath Culvert currently in use (i.e. draining the North Portal to Drainage pond 1)?
